The selected candidates would work on a project sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi under the Covid19 Special Call titled "Covid-19 Induced Vulnerabilities and Coping Strategies of Small Producers: Two Case Studies from Gujarat and Telangana". The positions are purely temporary and based in Hyderabad. Preference will be given to those candidates with knowledge of Telugu, Urdu and English. The positions are available for the prescribed time period mentioned below.

- (a) Research Assistant – 1 (3 months)
- (b) Field Investigator – 1 (45 days)

- (a) Research Assistant @Rs.17,000/- p.m. (Qualification-Ph.D./M.Phil./Post Graduate in Social Science discipline with minimum 55% marks)
