CSD is a premier research institute which is supported by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Government of Telangana and the Reserve Bank of India. The institute's main areas of research fall under the broad category of sustainable development with a focus on the poor and the marginalised. The current areas of research at the institute include education, health, nutrition, livelihoods, natural resource extraction and externalities, poverty and equity. For the positions currently available at CSD, preference would be given to those who have undertaken research and possess work experience in the above mentioned topics especially on sustainable development goals, health care and nutritional status of mother and child, inclusive education and the impact of pandemic on livelihoods, health and education.

For the academic year 2021-22, **CSD invites applications to the following positions.**

A. PROJECT FELLOW: SIX (UR: 3; SC: 1; ST; 1; OBC: 1)

- (a) Any discipline in the social sciences (2)
- (b) Economics (4)

Duration of Tenure: Initially for one year. Continuation into second year will be decided on expert appraisal of work and interview at the end of first year.

Essential Qualifications: Ph. D in relevant discipline

The applicants must have thorough knowledge of field-based research studies and willingness to travel for extended period to rural areas along with a good understanding of quantitative and qualitative data methods and analysis, data generation and tabulation (use of STATA/SPSS/Excel) and good writing skills in English. Knowledge of Telugu is desirable.

Remuneration: Rs. 50,000 per-month with a standard 10% increase in the second year.

This is a full-time position that requires attendance as per the regulations of the institute that apply to the full-time staff of the institute. Candidates will be required to work on institutional projects under the supervision of faculties of the institute. The position involves field travel, data processing skills and writing skills.

All applicants must attach copies of publications if any and PhD thesis synopsis.

B. RESEARCH ASSOCIATES: FIVE (3 UR; 1 SC; 1 ST)

- (a) Any discipline in the social sciences (2)
- (b) Economics (3)

Duration of Tenure: Initially for one year. Continuation into second year will be decided on expert appraisal of work and interview at the end of first year.

Essential qualification: M.A. in the any social science discipline with an aggregate of 55% marks.

Desirable qualification: M. Phil in the relevant discipline and/or research experience.

Remuneration: Rs. 40,000 per month with a 10 percent increase in the second year.

The applicants must be ready to undertake regular field visits for extended period to rural areas. Good understanding of field-based research studies, quantitative and qualitative data methods and analysis, data generation and tabulation (use of SPSS/Excel) and goodwriting skills in English are essential.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Short-listed candidates are required to attend an interview at CSD, Hyderabad.

The Selection Committee reserves the right not to make appointments and is free to consider scholars who have not applied, but whose work is known. However, such scholars will be required to attend the interview along with the applicants.

The Institute reserves the right to change the number of available positions without any notice.

As these are temporary positions that follow strict timelines of specific research grants by different sponsors, the Institute reserves the right to fill the total number of available positions with candidates possessing requisite qualifications, in the event of insufficient applications from suitable candidates belonging to the respective reserved categories.
