



**Online Training Programme on
Effects of Extreme Climate Events on Labour:
Challenges and Mitigation**

The aim of the above-mentioned four-day online course is to enhance the knowledge, understanding and capacity of the participants on matters relevant to extreme climatic events, decent work and status of labour welfare in rural and transitional areas. The specific objectives of the training programme are: (1) To sensitize the participants about potential impact of extreme climate events on different segments of the labour force and their working conditions; To familiarize the participants about the negative effects of climate instability and extreme weather events on employment vulnerability; and, (3) To acquaint the participants on various laws and other social security nets for the workers focusing on climate risk resilience, adaptation and labour security.

The training programme is meant for personnel working in various governmental and non-governmental organizations, Government officials, Professionals from Research Institutes, Policy Research Organizations; Representatives from Central Trade Unions, Researchers and Students to build their knowledge, skills and perspectives towards building a larger policy context for identifying the impacts emerging from the extreme climate events that the communities encounter. The entire exercise will be helpful to understand the adaptation decision making process as well as to identify the interventions required at different levels.

The course will be conducted online from 10.30 am to 4.30 pm on each day. Each session will be followed by questions and answers. Participation and interaction is compulsory. Course certificates will be provided after the successful completion of the course.
