The Telangana Social Development Report 2022: Barriers to Education (TSDR 2022) is the Special Report on the Status of Telangana Education. The report examines the dynamics of child education, reasons for school dropout and never enrolment, and major issues of girls and women from different ages and social groups who are not enrolled in higher educational institutions among selected households, dynamics of opting for private schooling, and gender differences in opting for different courses. The study covered a total of 67927 households, specifically identified 7620 sampled students across the districts of the state. This report reflects important issues in the domain of education and policy-making, particularly in the context of education in the state of Telangana.
